Bus Discipline Policy for Shaunavon Public School

This policy has been created based on the Chinook School Division Administrative Policy AP 351, Student Conduct on School Buses, that outlines procedures that will be undertaken in the event of inappropriate student conduct on a bus.

All bus incidents need to be reported on the Student Bus Conduct Form, as available through the link at the bottom of this page.

- First Incident will result in a verbal warning from school administration and a call home.
- **Second Incident** will result in a call home with a same day/next day removal of bus privileges or appropriate in-school consequences.
- Third Incident will result in a call home and a three day removal of bus privileges
- Fourth Incident will result in a call home with a possible extension of the three day removal of privileges. This decision will be made in consultation with the superintendent of learning.

Please note, that Administration, in collaboration with Transportation Manager/Bus Driver/Superintendent, reserves the right to alter consequences according to the severity of the incident.

An exception to the bus policy would be if the student crosses our school's bottom lines during bus transport. The determination of length of removal of privileges will be determined by school administration in consultation with the Superintendent of Learning.

School Bottom Lines

- 1. Physical fighting
- 2. Physical attack of staff
- 3. Verbal attack of staff and/or students
